Post-Procedure Instructions

Following your procedure today, please review the instructions below:

- 1. The day of the procedure keep your activity level low, relax, no strenuous activity.
- 2. No physical therapy for 2 days.
- 3. You may resume work unless told otherwise by the physician.
- 4. Remove band aid from injection site when bleeding stops. (Leave no longer than 12 hours.)
- 5. Please use cold compress on the day of the procedure and warm compress the following day (only 15 minutes every hour as tolerated) if necessary.
- 6. Common side effects from procedures include:
 - > Flushing or feeling of warmth
 - > Increased water retention
 - ➤ Leg cramps
 - ➤ Increase in appetite
 - > Increased menses
 - ➤ Increase in blood glucose levels. Note: If you are diabetic, you should monitor your blood sugar levels closely

These side effects are to be expected and should not be cause for concern.

- 7. If you experience any of the following symptoms within 48 hours after today's procedure, please call the office at (432) 333-5200 or 1-888-724-6001 (after hours) or go to the nearest ER
 - > Redness, swelling, and/or drainage at the injection site
 - > Fever and/or chills
 - > Severe headache
 - ➤ An increase in weakness, back/neck pain, numbness and tingling in arms or legs or incontinence of bowel or bladder
 - ➤ If you had a thoracic (Upper or midback) procedure and have shortness of breath call numbers above or go to the ER right away
